#### 1. Chair Remarks

The Chair wished to thank Christina Donald, Curator of McManus: Dundee's Museum and Art Gallery, for hosting the SAFAP meeting at the Collection Unit on Barrack Street.

The Chair also thanked Andrew Brown for his hard work related to the Code of Practice Review.

She also welcomed George Dalgleish, Keeper of Scottish History and Archaeology, NMS, to the meeting and thanked him for attending the meeting as the ex officio member from NMS for this meeting in place of Jilly Burns who was unable to attend.

The chair informed the panel of her intention to appoint a Vice-Chair to deal with proceedings in the event of her absence. She suggested Neil Curtis as a potential candidate, which was accepted by NC.

## 3. QLTR Business

Andrew Brown reported to the panel that the reviewed Code of Practice will be launched on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2014.

Amongst other positive changes the COP review will allow for remote communications between panel members and for decisions to be taken outside SAFAP meetings. This includes the claiming of excavation assemblages.

AP – SC to write letters to stakeholders informing them of the COP launch AP – JY to highlight with MGS that the revised Code is being issued.

#### 4. Treasure Trove Unit Report

The release of the Annual Report was successful with good media coverage from BBC Scotland news website, BBC Radio Scotland and national papers.

NF appeared in BBC Two Quest for Bannockburn for Bannockburn shown in June, identifying the finds that had been recovered during the archaeological survey.

Currently developing the next batch of finds days and workshops. Two recent Finds Days have included the McManus Museum and the Kelvingrove Museum & Art Galllery. The aim is to target areas where metal detectorists are active, or where there is potential under reporting. The next series of workshops for museum professionals and non-professionals will be at an event at Nairn Museum and in Orkney Museum.

SC is currently in discussion with the Dig it! team to establish a TT input for events across Scotland. This will consist of an online presence and the production of posters as an educational tool.

SC discussed with the panel operational considerations when implementing `an amnesty' for finders to report any previously unreported finds.

SC reported to the panel discussions with ALGAO and representatives of commercial units in relation to the process of reporting archaeological assemblages to Treasure Trove.

SC raised the matter of ex gratia awards in relation to the conduct of finders which was followed by a Panel discussion of the considerations arising.
